

The Competition Consortium: Texas Fire Danger Information Link Page

County Burning Bans are established by County Judges or County Commissioners' Courts. The Texas Forest Service maintains very up-to-date maps of counties having burn bans and other wild fire danger information (see links below). However, the ultimate source for burn ban information is your local county officials.

Texas Forest Service Burn Ban Map
